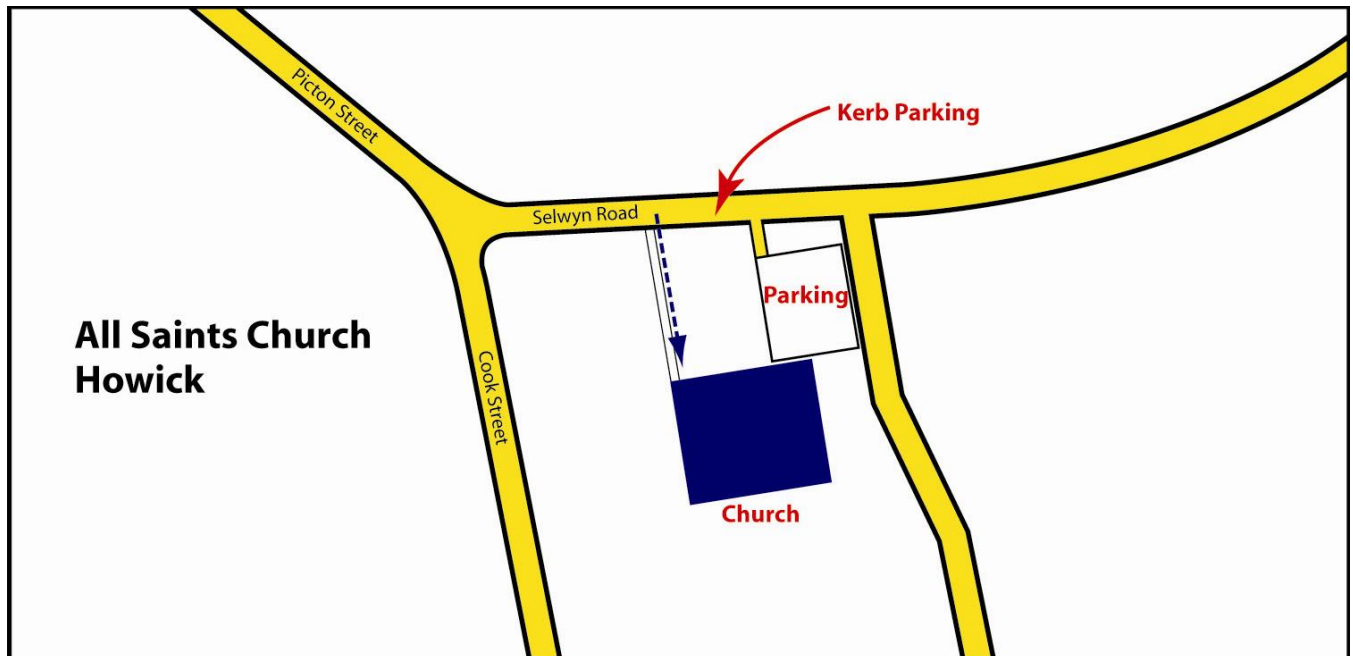


All Saints Church, Howick

17 Selwyn Road



Candidates should arrive at the exam venue 15 minutes before their exam time.



All Saints is the larger modern church, not the small wooden church nearer Cook Street. Access is via a covered pedestrian walkway which runs in from Selwyn Road. Parking is available in Selwyn road and in the Church grounds.

Candidates should follow the signs within the church building and report to the exam steward at the top of the stairs. The exam room is downstairs, and you will be taken there by the steward. Candidates should come warmed up, although there is sometimes space available for candidates to have an additional quick warm up before their exam.

The exams are held in a medium sized carpeted room with concrete walls and a reasonably dry acoustic. The piano is a Yamaha upright with an adjustable piano stool.
