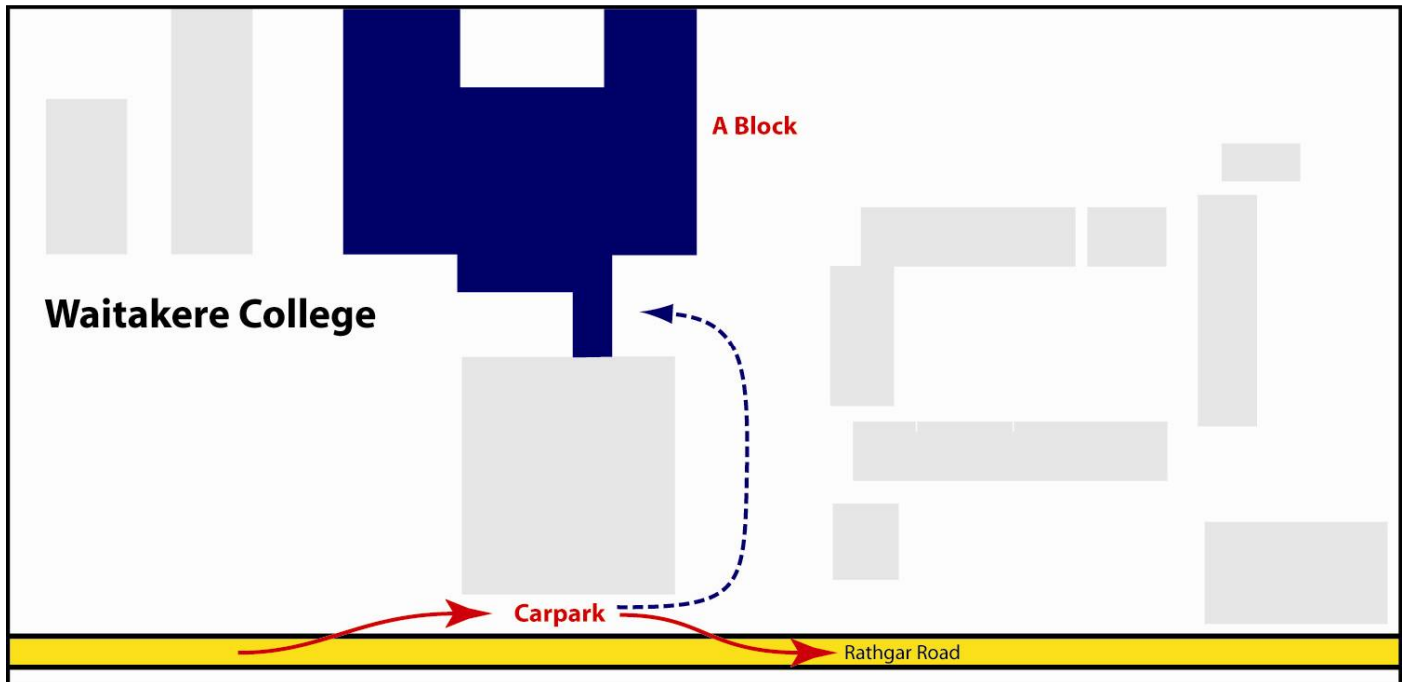


## Exam Venue Information for Waitakere College

### The exam begins at 9.30am

Candidates should be ready outside their exam room by 9.10am



There is a small amount of parking available within the school grounds. Alternatively, candidates may be dropped off in this parking area. Signs will be in place to direct candidates to the exam rooms.

The A block is the large building which is connected to the front reception block by a covered walkway. Candidates will be allocated to rooms according to their grade. Room allocations will be clearly displayed on the day, and candidates can check their name on the lists outside.

### What should I bring?

- Candidates must bring their own stationery – pencil, eraser, ruler, and pencil sharpener. Papers worked in pencil are accepted - answers do not need to be 'inked in'.
- It is not necessary for candidates to present an exam slip or other paperwork on arrival
- Candidates should leave their bags and any other belongings at the front of the exam room. Cell phones must be turned off and left at the front of the room.

### How long will it take?

- The maximum time allowed for the examination is:
  - Grades 1 to 3: 1½ hours (finish by 11.00am)
  - Grades 4 to 5: 2 hours (finish by 11.30am)
  - Grades 6 to 8: 3 hours (finish by 12.30pm)
- Candidates may leave the examination room after 10.10am (but not return), so arrangements should be made for younger candidates to be met should they finish early.
